

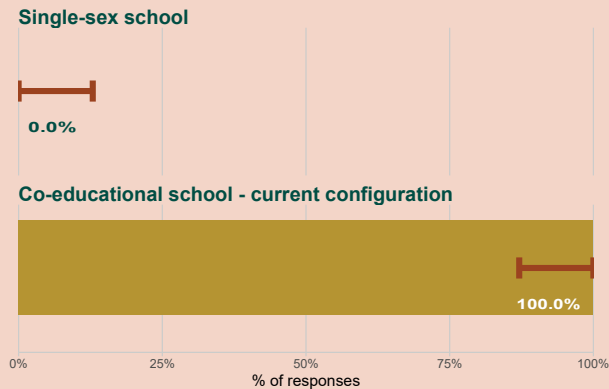

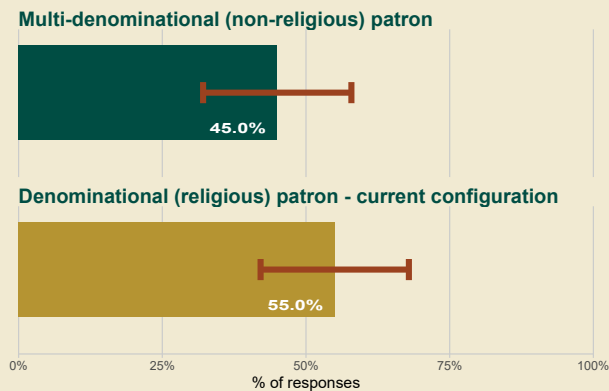

Results from parents and guardians with children in this school

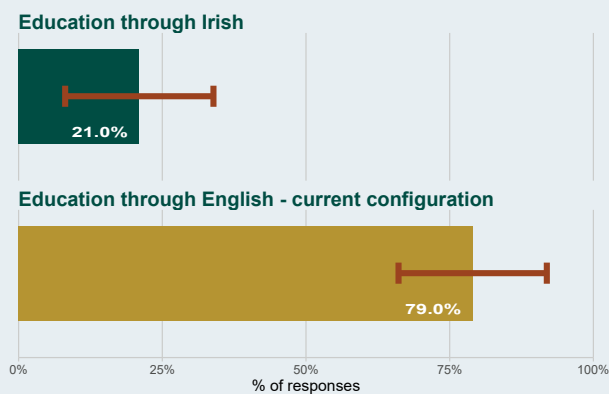
Co-educational / single-sex preference
